JOB SUMMARY: This position has been known as the Intensive Supervision Officer (ISO) that indeed is a probation officer working the non-traditional time periods.

- This position serves the agency during the non-tradition hours identified as following:
 - 4:30 p.m. – 8:00 a.m. (direct services hours and on-call duties)
 - Weekends
 - Holidays, and a
 - Rotating schedule.
- This probation officer position is an extension of the day officers working the traditional hours also known as the day shift and performs assigned duties during the non-traditional hours.
- This position is the first responder to after-hour crisis, arrests, and needs identified by law enforcement agencies. Placement arrangements and transportation to detention or shelter facilities are the obligations of this officer.
- This position assists in insuring accountability and compliance to the court of juvenile offenders by attending to the electronic monitors; by performing random urine analysis testing for juvenile clients and parents; and by responding to emergency situations that require mental health assessments and placements if warranted.
- The evening officer conducts intense supervision for serious offenders and random supervision for non-violent offenders through home visits, verifying curfew compliance, insuring restricted associations with other offenders and non-use of drug and alcohol products.
