BE IT ENACTED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF BAXTER COUNTY, STATE OF ARKANSAS,
AN ORDINANCE TO BE ENTITLED:

AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING BAXTER COUNTY TO CONDUCT BUSINESS WITH BENNY
MAGNESS PURSUANT TO ACT 353 (ACA § 14-14-1202).

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE QUORUM COURT OF BAXTER COUNTY,
ARKANSAS, THAT:

Section 1. It is the best interest of Baxter County that all offices of Baxter County have the authorization to conduct business with a helicopter pilot for Baxter County Sheriff Department and a county employee, who is the owner of Magness Oil Company, 167 Tucker Cemetery Road in Gassville, Arkansas.

Section 2. Due to the unusual circumstance, and difficult to find appropriate goods, services and commodities this ordinance allows Baxter County to do business with the named employee.

Section 3. The equipment that Baxter County will purchase is used electronic equipment that is much less expensive than purchasing it new. This equipment will put the Baxter County helicopter in compliance with new Federal Aviation Regulations.

Section 4. This Ordinance permits such purchase, but is limited in scope to matters related to the Baxter County Helicopter.

Section 5. EMERGENCY CLAUSE. That this policy shall be effective in the manner prescribed by ACA § 14-14-1202 immediately upon its passage and approval by the Baxter County Quorum Court.
